



WELL NO. 3 LOAN AUTHORIZATION BYLAW APPROVAL PROCESS

NOTICE OF ALTERNATIVE APPROVAL PROCESS

This notice is the first of two notices to advise electors in the District of Clearwater of the intention to adopt Well No. 3 Loan Authorization Bylaw No. 165, 2017. The purpose of the bylaw is to borrow an amount not to exceed \$323,593.40 to finance the cost to construct a third well that will be repaid over a period not to exceed ten (10) years. It is estimated that the borrowing will result in a parcel tax to property owners within the defined water supply area in the amount of \$32.62 per year for the 10-year period. The Well will provide and enhance our water system to be a safe and reliable water source for the community and its future growth. A copy of Bylaw 165, 2017 and a summary of the proposal area available from the District's office during each business day of the week between 8:30 am and 4:30 pm.

The Council proposes to borrow the money and undertake the construction of a third Well unless, by 4:00 pm on October 9th, 2017, at least 10 percent of the electors in the defined water service area described in the attached map sign an elector response form opposing the implementation of the proposal unless the Council holds a vote (ie: referendum).

The number of elector responses required to prevent the District from proceeding unless a vote is held is estimated to be **156**. A report respecting the basis on which this determination is made is available upon request from the District.

The Elector Response Forms are required to be submitted to the District of Clearwater on forms that can be obtained during regular business hours from the District office at the District office (209 Dutch Lake Road) during regular office hours, Monday to Friday between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. and on the District's website at www.districtofclearwater.ca. Bylaw No. 165 may also be viewed in these locations.

Who May Sign the Elector Response Form: Only those electors of the defined water service area for the District are eligible to sign the elector response forms. There are two types of electors – resident electors and non-resident property electors.

Deadline: Elector Response Forms must be received by the District's Corporate Officer before **4:00 p.m. on Monday, October 9, 2017**. Faxed or emailed submissions will not be accepted and only elector response forms provided by the District or an accurate copy of the form.
